In fact, during our Super Gas days, we built the car from a ‘51 model. When we moved up to Top Sportsman in 2007, we had to adopt a more aerodynamic design but kept the Henry J’s distinctive styling.

We’ve hit many milestones in Top Sportsman, with two NHRA D1 championships, three national event wins, twelve divisional wins, eight NHRA national round appearances, and a career-best time of 6.32 seconds at 225 mph in the quarter mile. But after many years of success and good luck, it is time to refresh the technology to stay competitive.

With the continuing support of Kaeser Compressors we commissioned a new

Top Sportsman for the 2024 season. Kirkman Composites crafted Terry Hall’s body in full carbon fiber, with the finishing touches and paint applied by Jeff Hoskins, featuring the bright new scheme by Gos Motorsports Graphics. Jerry Bickel Race Cars built the chassis and completed the integration. Under the hood, the dragster is powered by a Sonny Leonard 762 Next Generation Hemi engine. Our Super Henry II, with its unique hand-finished details, remains the only one of its kind in the NHRA circuit.
